AWS re/Start is a full-time, classroom-based development and training program that prepares individuals for entry-level cloud positions. After 12 weeks of training, collaborating organizations connect AWS re/Start program graduates with potential employers.

What training do AWS re/Start learners complete?

Each diverse cohort of learners, supported by professional mentors and accredited trainers, completes cloud training featuring scenario-based learning, hands-on labs, and coursework. Learners also focus on topics such as adaptive communication, time management, and collaboration.

AWS re/Start graduates pursue entry-level cloud roles in operations, site reliability, and infrastructure support. In these positions, graduates use Python scripts, support Linux operating systems, operate network infrastructures, deploy basic AWS core services, and carry out initial troubleshooting.
